If instead you prefer to stay in town the first weekend in April, you can visit the **Southern Ideal Home Show** on April 5-7 at the NC State Fairgrounds.*

*For the second weekend in April, you might enjoy the **25th Annual Pleasure Island Seafood, Blues, and Jazz Festival** being held in Kure Beach on April 13-14 or the **33rd Annual NC Pickle Festival** in Mount Olive on April 12-13.
